
Daisy Learning Focus Share Spring Term 3

We hope you had a lovely half term week – thank you for sending the photographs in to share with us the things you have been doing at home and also your experiences of completing the home learning activities. We love to see what the children have been doing and they enjoy sharing them with the other children in our family time.





In family time we have been looking at where people live, and the different types of houses and places others might live. Some of the children have been keen to draw their house and who lives in there with them.







To link in with 'The three little pigs' story that we have been focusing on, we have been completing a treasure hunt in the garden. The children have been looking for the different photos of the pigs and houses and they have tried to find where the same picture was on their clipboard to match them. They used pencils/crayons to make marks on their paper to make a note of which ones they found.





We have been watching 'Sticky kids' on the interactive whiteboard and moving our bodies to the music and copying the actions that the children on the video do. The children have loved stretching, standing up, sitting down, and turning around. It is a wonderful way for the children to think about the ways they can move their body. The children have enjoyed exploring the paints using rollers and paint brushes. Some children loved the sensory experience of the paint and preferred using their hands to explore the material. Some children chose to make fingerprints and handprints on their paper as they liked the feel of the paint on their body. Some children liked mixing the paints together to see what colours they could make and enjoyed squeezing the paints out to make different colours. We talked about the colours of the paint and how the colour changed when other colours were mixed into it.
