<u>OUTDOORS</u> – Plant a seed and watch how it grows. It could be a bean, or a flower. Cress grows very quickly.

<u>CREATIVE</u> – Draw or paint a picture of a Spring flower.

Create Spring leaves with paint. Cut a leaf shape out of paper. Fold in half and open out. Drip paint onto one side of the paper. Fold again and press down. Open the paper to reveal a symmetrical pattern.

<u>RED NOSE DAY ACTIVITY</u> – To celebrate Red Nose Day, have a go at the following activities:- Throw balls into a bucket. Make a tally of how many are on target. Play skittles and again keep score.
